BACK OF CARD: RULES SUMMARY

- **3rd - 6th grade games: 18 min halves; 7th - 12th grades: 20 min halves.**
- **4th - 12th grade: The clock stops during the last 2 minutes of EACH HALF and for all time outs. The clock stops on all free throw attempts in the SECOND HALF. (Clock does not stop in 3rd grade except for timeouts).**
- **TIMEOUTS: 3rd-12th- (3) 60-second time outs per game. Teams get ONE timeout in OT.**
- **29.5 inch (large) ball for 6th-12th boys' games.**
- **Must have 4 players to start the game (10 minute grace period from scheduled start time).**
- **Free Throws: 3rd and 4th grade shoot from 13 feet. 3rd grade may cross the line; 4th grade may NOT.**
- **Overtime: 5th - 12th grade, ONE 2-minute overtime. No OT for 3rd and 4th grade. Games may end in tie.**
- **4th - 6th Grade PRESS Rule: No pressing allowed on any inbound play into the back court UNTIL the last 2 minutes of the GAME. A dribbler must be allowed to enter the front court; defense back 10 feet (volleyball line). Pressing allowed on any rebound or steal at any time.**
